MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: THE PARADISE CHOCOLATE FEST.

Event is rain or shine. In the event the Fest is cancelled, Paradise Chocolate Fest, Inc. will be responsible to refund prepaid space fee and has no other liabilities with regard to this event.

Sellers are required to provide their own canopies/tents, dividers, tables, chairs, trash receptacle, and to take all your trash with you. Booth space is 10' x 10'.

Infrastructure set-up for the festival will be permitted on Friday, May 7, between 3 p.m. to 5 p.m.
Set-up must be completed by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 8. Security will be provided on Friday night.
The hours for the festival are Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. No early tear-down.

Exhibitors will be advised by postcard of their acceptance to the festival within 2 weeks of receipt of completed application and full payment. An exhibitor's packet and parking permit will be mailed out no later than 10 days before the festival.
